

Communication & Language

Listen to stories with attention & recall
Joins in with repeated refrains
Show an understanding of prepositions
Respond to simple instructions
Begin to use 'and' and 'because'
Uses vocabulary focused on objects and people that are of particular importance to them.
Builds up vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences.
Uses talk in pretending that objects stand for something else

Maths

Recite numbers in order to 10.
Knows that numbers identify how many objects are in a set.
Begin to represent numbers using fingers, marks on paper or pictures.
Sometimes matches numeral and quantity correctly.
Show an interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects.
Show an awareness of similarities of shapes in the environment.
Use positional language.

Being Imaginative

Enjoys joining in with dancing and ring games and begins to move rhythmically.
Uses various construction materials and begins to construct, stacking blocks vertically and horizontally, making enclosures and creating spaces, joining construction pieces together to build and balances.
Beginning to engage in imaginative role-play based on own first-hand experiences.

Begin to play in groups.
Form good relationships.
Select activities with help.
Build confidence when asking for help.

Understanding the World

Show an interest in the lives of people who are familiar to them.
Talk about significant events in their own experience.
Can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects.
Develop an understanding of growth, decay and changes over time.
Show an interest in technological toys with knobs or pulleys, or real objects such as cameras.

Physical

Move freely and with pleasure and confidence in a range of ways.
Draw lines and circles using gross motor movements.
Observe the effects of activity on their bodies.
Manage washing and drying hands.
Dresses with help, e.g. puts arms into open-fronted coat or shirt when held up, pulls up own trousers, and pulls up zipper once it is fastened at the bottom.

Literacy

Enjoy rhyming activities.
Listens to and joins in with stories and poems, one-to-one and also in small groups.
Look at books independently.
Handle books carefully.
Sometimes gives meaning to marks as they draw and paint.
Ascribe meanings to marks that they see in different places.
